The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has prepared a proposed Kansas Water Pollution Control Permit, A-SASA-H001, for Osborne Asset Holdings, LLC, Smoky Hills Genetics, LLC, located near Smolan, Kansas. This is an existing swine operation. The proposed permit is for a swine breeding through farrowing operation with facilities for a gilt development unit with the proposed maximum capacity for 8,982 head (3,592.8 animal units) of swine weighing more than 55 pounds, and 11,586 head (1,158.6 animal units) of swine weighing less than 55 pounds; for a total of 4,751.4 animal units of swine. The proposed modifications and improvements to the facility will include the construction of a mortality compost facility and three new confinement buildings to replace the existing swine confinement buildings. Accumulated manure and waste will be collected and stored in the existing waste management system which consists of fourteen (14) earthen wastewater retention structures. The facility is located in the East Half of Section 24, Township 15 South, Range 4 West and North Half of Section 19, Township 15 South, Range 3 West in Saline County, Kansas.

A notice in the Kansas Register dated July 14, 2016, printed below, will inform the public of the availability of the proposed water pollution control permit for Osborne Asset Holdings, LLC, Smoky Hills Genetics, LLC. #### Article 8.—APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS

(Editor's Note: A set of Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board Temporary Administrative Regulations (K.A.R. 102-8-1, 102-8-2, 102-8-4, and 102-8-6 through 102-8-12) was published in the July 7, 2016 Kansas Register. The authorizing statute in K.A.R. 102-8-8 was published incorrectly, so the corrected 102-8-8 is republished below. The publication was also incorrectly titled as *Permanent Administrative Regulations* instead of *Temporary Administrative Regulations*.)

**102-8-8. Renewal audit.** (a) Each licensee selected for a random audit shall submit the following to the board within 30 days after the license expiration date:

(1) The completed renewal audit forms; and

(2) either the original continuing education documents that validate all continuing education hours claimed for credit during the current renewal period or other documentation of completed continuing education hours approved by the board.

(b) Continuing education hours that a renewal applicant earns after board receipt of the renewal application form shall not be approved for continuing education credit for the period being audited.

(c) Failure to comply with this regulation shall be considered unprofessional conduct. (Authorized by K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 65-7505; implementing K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 65-7504 and 65-7405; effective, T-102-6-29-16, June 29, 2016.)
